

Talk 1:

BIBLE READING John 6: 25-44 (Dramatised)

They found him on the west side of the lake and asked, "Rabbi, when did you get here?" answered, "I Jesus tell you certain that you are not looking for me because you saw the miracles, but because you ate all the food you wanted. Don't work for food that spoils. Work for food that gives eternal life. The Son of Man will give you this food, because God the Father has given him the right to do so."
